Round Logs — Spec Sheet & Buyer Checklist

This reference summarises Atlantic Logs & Lumber’s Liberian round-log programme: featured species, dimensional ranges, container and break-bulk shipping specifications, loading ports, and the traceability and on-site inspection process applied before cargo departs Liberia. Use it to prepare a structured enquiry or purchase order.

Azobe / Ekki	Lophira alata	Marine works, bridges, heavy construction	Extremely dense & durable; primary Liberian product
Tali	Erythrophleum ivorense	Heavy structural, decking, port works	Hard, durable; suits marine & exterior use
Iroko	Milicia excelsa	Joinery, decking, boat-building	Stable, weather-resistant hardwood

Species availability is confirmed per enquiry. Non-Azobe species are offered subject to current sourcing and concession supply.

Log length	5.0 m – 12.0 m (standard 6, 8, 10, 12 m)
Grade	FAS / merchantable; buyer specification honoured
Marking	Species, log ID, diameter & length marked on log end
Volume per 40ft container	~22–28 m ³ (species & log size dependent)
Volume per break-bulk shipment	500 m ³ – 5,000 m ³ + per parcel

COMPLIANCE

Traceability & Legality

Atlantic Logs & Lumber sources exclusively through licensed Liberian concessionaires and authorised suppliers. Every log is traceable from concession to loading port. Documentation is prepared to support the buyer's import formalities and internal compliance.

Licensed concessions	Supply is drawn from Forestry Development Authority (FDA) licensed concessions and authorised holders only.
Chain-of-custody	Concession source, harvest date, hauler and yard reception are recorded for each parcel.
Log-level identification	Each log is marked at the end with species code, log ID, diameter and length.
Government documentation	FDA and applicable export documentation is prepared for every shipment.
Phytosanitary certification	Issued at loading in accordance with destination-country requirements.
Commercial documentation	Commercial invoice, packing list, certificate of origin, and bill of lading issued per shipment.

On-site Inspection & Quality Control

Atlantic's Liberian team supervises log reception, yard grading and container or vessel loading. The following checks are completed before cargo departs Liberia:

✓ Species verification against buyer specification
✓ Log-by-log diameter & length measurement
✓ Visual defect assessment (splits, shakes, rot, insect damage)
✓ End-face grading & rejection of out-of-spec logs
✓ Log identification & marking cross-checked to packing list
✓ Photographic record of yard inventory prior to loading

- ✓ Container / hold stowage supervised for safe transport
- ✓ Seal numbers recorded and communicated to buyer
- ✓ Final loading tally issued alongside commercial documents

Buyer Enquiry Checklist

To prepare a structured response, please share as much of the following as possible with your enquiry:

☐	Species	Preferred species (e.g. Azobe, Tali, Iroko) and acceptable alternates
☐	Diameter range	Minimum & maximum small-end diameter (cm)
☐	Length range	Preferred log lengths (m); fixed lengths or assortment
☐	Grade	FAS, merchantable, or buyer-specific grade rules
☐	Volume	Total m ³ required and delivery cadence (one-off or programme)
☐	Shipping mode	Containerised (40ft) or break-bulk
☐	Destination port	Discharge port & country; inland delivery if required
☐	Incoterm	FOB, CFR or CIF preferred quotation basis
☐	Buyer entity	Registered company name, country, contact person
☐	Timeline	Target loading window and first delivery date
